This year is a milestone for ACME and I'm proud to be leading the ACME team as we celebrate 125 years of serving our communities. ACME operates 178 stores in six states – Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Delaware, Maryland, New York, and Connecticut – and we have the most loyal and dedicated team of 20,000 associates. We are the strongest and healthiest we have been in over 20 years. Our associates and customers deserve a new ACME that is enriched with our legacy and a culture that embraces change and shapes a new food experience in our stores.

Remaining faithful to our values has been the heart of ACME for the past 125 years. Taking care of our associates, making ACME a fun place to work, and being very deliberate with recognition is the heart and soul of our organization. # For President Dan Croce, Customer Focus, Associate

Food World/Food Trade News: Since being named president of ACME Markets about a year ago, what have been the most surprising aspects of the job? The biggest challenges?

Dan Croce: The biggest challenge by far in the last year was not so much becoming the president of ACME but making sure that we meet the expectations of our customers and associates every day. That's my number one priority. Running parallel to that this year is the pure growth, expansion, and the accelerated rate of our division - which is unique to ACME. Taking ACME to 178 stores has simply been unbelievable. To say it was a challenge is an understatement, however, I personally thrive off of challenges and so does the ACME nation. What's exciting is that we are not just enduring our business but we are creating the future. This is an opportunity of a lifetime. This year has gone by quickly and I would almost like to say that I really haven't felt like the president this year. Everything has been moving so quickly with expanding the company, driving our business, and working as one team.

Food World/Food Trade News: A lot of our readers have seen the before and the after of the 71 ACME-acquired converted stores and said, "that's unbelievable." Can you give us a little color on the process you went through? Tell us what really happened, how did the plan come to life and how was the ACME nation able to do so much in such a short period of time.

Dan Croce: It was an amazing and probably the most intense logistical process I have ever seen. I have had the pleasure of having some good teachers over my life in process management and that goes back to the first question of how I almost felt like I was not the president, because it was more of a completely new and different job task. It all started with going out and doing the diligence for the stores and being intimately involved in which stores we were going to submit for purchase. Once we narrowed that list down and formed our 71-store list, we went on to put in our bid and it all was accepted. Simultaneously, we were building the process map to flip these stores. We built process maps determining whether to take the stores dark for an extended period of time or open them quickly. We had to determine if we should close them down for five days, or for four days. We ended up doing a 64hour flip because the stores were declining at an accelerated rate and we needed to do something compelling and quick. During the months of April, May, June, July, and August we recruited, developed, and organized a process team here at ACME for turning the stores. It was all boots on the ground and we organized every aspect of the company. From culture to communications to information



technology to warehousing to logistics to pharmacy operations to store operations to merchandising to pricing, we had it covered. All of those intricate work streams flowed together to formalize our 64-hour plan. Believe it or not, we organized a process map over those months that went down to the minute on what we were getting done. It also detailed when and how all of those work streams would coincide and work in harmony as opposed to chaos. It did feel a little chaotic at times, but nonetheless, we were able to flip 71 stores and each store took 64 hours exactly. There was not one miss.

Food World/Food Trade News: Obviously, the A&P bankruptcy didn't occur until July, but the writing was on the wall much earlier than that. So, you began your plan in April even before you knew exactly when the stores would become available. How were you able to devise a plan between the bankruptcy on July 21 and the bid you submitted two weeks later?

Dan Croce: We weren't able to access the stores based on our ownership, but we were certainly working with A&P to submit requests for various diligence work, whether it was just pure facility assessment or people assessment. We worked with A&P to have opportunities to visit. One honorable note – the number one work stream we focused on was culture and combining the two companies on Day One. We are still working on it to this day but this remains a focus area for us. Our first primary request of A&P was for an official visit, and we toured all 71 stores in mid-July. At that time, we did two-hour sessions with the associates of every single store to talk about who we are, what we

are, and what we planned to do. It was important to keep the morale and spirit for the team alive. That was by far our biggest task. I will say this, from a process perspective, we worked really hard for the Albertsons family of stores to climb to a higher altitude. We wrote a blueprint, if you will, to outline the entire process for future opportunities and acquisitions.

Food World/Food Trade News: What did you learn? What assumptions that you made earlier in the process actually ended up changing radically? Because, everything again was done outside-in. You didn't really get into the guts of it until you brought the crews in.

Dan Croce: We knew that the culture was the number one priority by far. So, kudos to us, we knew that, but we grossly underestimated how long it is really going to take to change the culture, and how much work is going to be required. That was by far the big-

gest priority we had and we recognized it was going to be the biggest challenge. I mean we are good operators, we know how to run stores, we know how to put it together, we know how to merchandise a store, but the biggest challenge was introducing our culture to 8,000 associates that were about to join our family.

Food World/Food Trade News: How much of an advantage was it that you had worked for A&P for a long time? That you knew the system, you knew the heartbeat, you knew some of the associates at least?

*Dan Croce*: Not much, really. I had been gone for 11 years. It was a completely different company than the one I left. The only value I had was I understood the network, the geography, and where the stores were positioned. But how they were doing business was grossly different from what I had left over a decade ago.

Food World/Food Trade News: What about from a mechanical point of view? Can you give our readers a little flavor on the turnaround process?

*Dan Croce:* From a process perspective, we had what we called "Day Zero." We arrived at 3:00 p.m. on day zero and opened up on day three. Days zero, one, and two were completely dark. We started by taking inventory and we levelled the books with A&P personnel. Then the transfer of assets in the store itself occurred. Our transfer occurred

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with the purchase of that particular store and immediately we went to work. We had various partners helping us throughout the transfer process. We had a tag team of upwards of 100 people in the store that helped retag the store in the first eight hours. Preset orders were in the pipeline for key commodities. We had a framework of merchandise to start building our displays and then we would get into actual order writing. The day of order writing would be the day of delivery and the process would follow through accordingly. Running parallel to that was a team removing the old IT systems and putting the new technology into the store. And, there was a team that facilitated all of the cleaning and sanitation protocols. The team then began to clean the entire store. There was a crew on the outside of the store pressure washing the entire building all while getting the building up to the best environmental code possible. We had great partners - Retail Merchandising Services, Inc. (RMSI) and Belfor International. RMSI is one of our current partners that work on our reset programs. Belfor International - another huge partner for us - helped us expedite the cleaning in such a short amount of time.

Food World/Food Trade News: And, for the record, the process began late in September, early in October?

Dan Croce: September 29 was the first day. All 71 stores were completed by November 18.

Food World/Food Trade News: You're in the first blush with the former A&P stores. You got them open by the holidays so you could take advantage of that strong business opportunity. Obviously everyone has admitted that the goal was "get them open, get it done." Can you explain to our readers what needs to be done moving forward, other than constantly nurturing the culture?

Dan Croce: The tangibles. Obviously we have a very strong network of stores in great communities that have been underserving those communities to differing degrees. For example, the store in Ortley Beach, New Jersey is a decent looking store inside, but that store needs a new



façade. We will get that place spruced up. Then of course we have stores like New Canaan, Connecticut, which is perhaps one of the wealthiest demographics in the country. Not only New Canaan, but Greenwich, Stanford and Riverside, Connecticut are really underserving those communities with the offerings that we have. That said, we have 27 remodels in the pipeline for those 71 new ACME stores and 23 remodels for our legacy stores. In total we have 50 remodels coming this year out of our 178 stores. To include Sea Isle City, NJ being a "scrape and rebuild" store that we will open for Memorial Day weekend. We also have Patterson, NY and Boonton, NJ in the pipeline to open in early June as well. The 27 new stores that are going to be getting remodeled are a big priority for us this year. Those remodels can be anywhere from a quick \$500,000 to \$1 million to get the décor right; to a multi-million dollar remodel to restructure the store and give it the investment that has been remiss in some cases for two decades. Simultaneously, we continue to look for opportunities such as Barnegat, NJ. Barnegat has been a great win for us and we are excited to be in the town of Barnegat.

Food World/Food Trade News: If this was 2010, and

you had been offered the opportunity corporately to take a shot at Barnegat, things would have been different. That leads to the question of what factors have been the most important in the turnaround of ACME over the past three years? Obviously, one is you had an open shot at Barnegat, you took advantage of it. You did it the right way. That in itself is to me illustrative of the microcosm of how things have changed. But, on a bigger plane, how have things changed for you, even though you weren't president then, you were certainly in the senior management circle.

Dan Croce: Honestly, in the traditional supermarket sector, I believe that a decentralized business model is the most effective method to drive business. That by far is the most important element of ACME's business from a structure perspective. When you think about business and you think about the supermarket industry specifically - what is your model? What is your structure? A centralized model doesn't work for divisions and companies such as ACME. We are a local East Coast chain that can

Croce joined ACME in 2005 as a district manager, the first ever recruited outside of the company. He held this position for three years before being appointed the director of operations in 2008. Croce's achievements within operational responsibility and his collaborative work with the operations and merchandising teams to drive top line sales and reduce operating costs led to his next appointments as vice president of sales support and then vice president of operations in 2010 and 2011 respectively. Croce was promoted to vice president of merchandising/marketing in 2014 before being promoted to president of the division in early 2015

Prior to joining ACME, Croce was with Super Fresh/A&P Food Markets where he started his grocery career in 1985. While at Super Fresh, he held positions that included co-manager, store director, director of customer service and district manager. He was part of the store management advisory board and received sponsorship to attend the executive education program of the American Food Management System.

Croce is a graduate of the University of Delaware where he earned a bachelor of science degree in agricultural business in 1991.

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win the hearts and the minds of the customers that we serve, but it has to be run locally. There are eight things I think about when I think about a decentralized business model. The first four things are people, process, partners, and performance. We are a people-first organization and we build processes that we need partners to help us drive and hopefully, if we focus on our people, our process, and partners, performance will fulfill itself. Running parallel to that, specifically within process and partners, we have full autonomy with price, promotion, product, and placement. That unto itself has been the biggest game changer for ACMF

Food World/Food Trade News: What about from the corporate end? Decentralized speaks of individuality, but from a corporate culture and a corporate mindset, allowing you to fly your own plane is one thing, but what else have they done in providing the support both financially and emotionally to let you ultimately become a different company?

Dan Croce: If I had to sum it up in one statement, I would say, decision making rights with accountability. Our corporate leaders, (Albertsons CEO) Bob Miller and his senior team believe in us, they reiterate their confidence in our ability to perform with a very clear line of sight in saying we have full autonomy to make decisions to move our business. But we are highly accountable for those decisions. Bob's model is very simple - you take care of the people that run your company, they will take care of the customers that shop your company and the wheels of business will continue to spin.

Food World/Food Trade News: For you, how much more inspirational - or maybe aspirational - is it to have a leader like Bob who is boots-on-the-ground vs. previous management whose style was definitely different

*Dan Croce:* Significantly different. I have a CEO that can specifically tell me not only about opportunities in our division because he has been boots on the ground to see our stores, but I also have a CEO who knows me, he knows my wife, he knows about my family, and he genuinely cares about me as a human being. That is by far the biggest differentiator.

Food World/Food Trade News: Using your crystal ball, how would you view the Delaware Valley and Metro New York landscapes 18 months from now?

*Dan Croce:* Great question. It is by far the most volatile time I can recall in my 30 years in the business in terms of what is happening with companies coming in and com-

panies going out. I will tell you this, it's exciting to be at ACME because of the market volatility and our growth. It's a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity for those of us who have been in the business for 10, 20 or 30 years. As for myself, I'm excited that I am at the helm of ACME leading this team to get better every day. With A&P closing 294 stores, we picked up 71 of them, Stop & Shop picked up 25, ShopRite picked up 16 and various independents picked up approximately another 30; that's significant change in itself. When we look at that, we see nothing but tremendous opportunity for future growth for ACME. I think the traditional supermarket will reaffirm itself in the Northeast corridor in totality as the food center of choice for customers. A locally driven supermarket chain is by far the biggest competitive advantage in the Northeastern part of the United States just because of how customers choose to shop, how their lifestyles are and the positioning of those stores being meaningful. The position of a store is important from a pure location perspective; but equally as important are the offerings and store experience for our customers inside the store. So take North Wilmington, DE for example. We picked up a store in the acquisition on Marsh Road and Silverside Road and it has been remiss of investment for over 20 years. With its great location we can position this store to be meaningful and relevant to its community once again. By expanding natural, organic, healthy, specialty, ethnic, and fresh offerings such as meals to go inside that footprint, we will reinvigorate a shopping experience in a very familiar location for the customers of North Wilmington.

Food World/Food Trade News: You are going to have a net number of stores get impacted by the competition. That doesn't mean it's going to be any less challenging as new people come in, does it?

Dan Croce: You have specialists such as Whole Foods and of course Wegmans that continue to look for property in our marketplace. I will tell you, I am not going to worry about their competitive advantage. I am going to illustrate and leverage our competitive advantage. Our competitive advantage is to be meaningful and relevant, again those are words, but I believe in them, from a food perspective. Food is an extraordinarily personal experience. If you are a local supermarket in a neighborhood that has been served by ACME for decades or for years or for one month or whatever it may be, our job is to connect with that community. We will do that with food and our people by running a very clean, fresh, and friendly store. Sounds hokey, but that is what we believe and that is what we say every day. If we are not inextricably linked to driving cleaner stores, lower prices, better ads, community partnerships, superior service, and of course, fresh produce each and every day, then we are working on the wrong things. That won't happen here at ACME.

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# Bill Crosby: At ACME Markets, It's All About The Stores

ACME Markets' vice president of operations Bill Crosby is like many executives in today's supermarket industry - he started his career when he was a teenager, working in the stores. "I've been in retail since I was 17, working in a Super Fresh cleaning pots and pans in the deli," he says.

Crosby held store manager positions at Super Fresh and ACME for several years before leaving the industry for a time. He joined the ACME team in Malvern, PA in 2009 as a store director before being promoted to district manager in 2010. He left the company for a short time before rejoining in 2014 as a district manager before being promoted to his current post. Along the way, Crosby earned a bachelor's degree from Villanova University.

Today, Crosby oversees the operations of all ACME stores, including the 71 former A&P locations the company recently

acquired. Under his purview are the brick and mortar stores, the store associates, safety and food safety, to name a few. In other words, as Crosby puts it, "Anything that deals with day-to-day store operations is my responsibility."

Like many on the ACME team, Crosby's career has spanned much change in the industry. He describes it this way: "First and foremost is probably the automation and computerization of the business. That has changed everything we do in the stores. Also having an influence on the supermarket industry as a whole is the impact of the large competitors that now operate in our region - Wal-Mart, Whole Foods, etc. And, don't forget online retailers, which pop up all the time."

Also changing are the consumers ACME serves. "The education of consumers today, with the availability of information from so

many sources, has really changed the way we market to our shoppers. All of the media outlets and the impact they have, from the 'Oprah Effect' to Dr. Oz. Trends used to take a while to develop, now they're showing up almost instantly, and constantly."


Aiding ACME's success in these ever-changing times is the strength of the Albertsons organization. Crosby tells us, "From top to bottom, they're all about the stores and the people. The recent success we've had is due to our decentralization under Albertsons. We can make the decisions that we know need to be made locally at store level. There are no levels, no channels to go through corporately. We run our division, which is so important."

Crosby is bullish on the company's prospects for greater success with the recent addition of the 71 A&P stores and is proud of the work ACME's team has done to integrate them into the company. "Our biggest challenge - and opportunity - with the new stores during and after the acquisition was convincing the associates that they could believe in us. After all, they had to change course so many times in the past few years. We were able to keep a lot of great associates and they are glad to be part of our winning team. So, we have been very busy in the stores and in our store support center working to build the team and help everyone learn to believe that they can win." Crosby says.

Looking forward, Crosby wants to urge the vendor community to be involved in ACME's growth and future success: "We're open for business. When we're given a program, we work hard to execute it at store level to ensure its success. If we aren't performing the way we should be, we want to hear from you. At the end of the day, we have three priorities - the first is sales, the second is sales and the third is sales. Vendors should see this as a win-win proposition of mutually driving sales that benefits both ACME Markets and the vendor we do business with. ACME is truly a company of its word. What we say we're going to do, we do."

# Kim Gray: Local Marketing Is Key To ACME's Success

Kim Gray, ACME Markets' vice president of marketing and merchandising, brings a lifetime of supermarket industry experience to his current post. He estimates he's spent about half of that career in operations and half of it in merchandising. Except for a short stint in in 2010-2012 with Giant/Landover, Gray's years have all been with Albertsons, in multiple capacities. He started as a store clerk, moving up to department manager, store manager and district manager before transitioning from stores to the store support center. He first was a grocery sales manager before moving up to the VP posts at several Albertsons divisions, including Dallas, Texas; Orlando, Florida; Houston, Texas before heading to ACME.

Today, Gray describes his job as: "Marketing ACME in the best light I can. It's my job to set our image and tell that story. The marketing and merchandising team works to get customers in the door so they can buy all of the products they're looking for."

In addition, he and his team oversee creation of the ads each week. Gray oversees the sales managers and works to balance the selling environment with responsive marketing - the action of building processes and strategies that behave differently based on your audience. Underlying all of that is his responsibility to oversee the company's profits and losses and manage expenses.

When asked to describe today's ACME, Gray says: "We have a term we use internally at ACME. It's, 'we're not your grandma's ACME anymore.' The market today demands that we stay current."

How does ACME stay current? Gray explains: "We have to keep in mind that today's shopper generally has more money to spend and less time in which to spend it. So, it's our job to identify what we can do to help them save time and make the shopping experience more enjoyable. First, it's about service. We do everything we can to make the shopping experience more 'comfortable.' That means we have Starbucks kiosks in the stores, our service deli has a wide selection of appetizing and convenient meal solutions, our hot foods are innovative and inviting."

While staying current, ACME also must keep in mind how the consumer has

changed, and will continue to change. Gray tells us: "People probably still eat the same thing every week that they always have, so their grocery list stays about the same. But they aren't satisfied with that, so it's up to us to figure out how to help them come up with new ideas. For example, our in-store fresh cut fruits and vegetables offer customers a time-saving way to eat healthier foods."

Gray also believes that more local marketing will be essential to ACME's continued success. "We want to be more embedded in our communities. ACME is local. We buy from local farms and local companies. This enables us to offer shoppers things they might not be able to find at other chains that might not be as focused on the communities as we are."

Gray is proud of the positive changes he's seen at ACME in the time since they have become part of the Albertsons team.

"How do you reinvigorate a company? Luckily, we have truly great leadership. We have the right people in place who believe in us at ACME and we have the right people focused on making it happy locally. It's a winning combination."

The addition of 71 A&P stores to the ACME banner has been a very exciting part of the retailer's recent resurgence. "The A&P acquisition has marked the first time that ACME has grown or expanded since the 1960s and 70s. It has been great to have the associates see that we are growing and moving forward, and that spirit has spread to the new ACME associates as well. It was very rewarding to be able to save tens of thousands of jobs at the A&P stores we acquired. Now, our job is to teach them that they need to sell their way to prosperity."

While the transition has been a huge task for all involved, Gray believes that the results have been very positive. "We did a pretty good job of folding people into the company. Now, we have to teach them the ACME way of doing business. It's not easy for them, but we've come light years from where we were at the start of the process. It's been quite the learning curve four our new team members, but a lot of training has taken place to help them merchandise to ACME standards.

There are many similarities between

the legacy ACME associates and the new ACME team. Gray explains: "I was very surprised when going over some statistics on the new ACME associates who were joining our team. The average tenure for an ACME store associate is 26 years, which I think is terrific. But, the average tenure for an A&P store associate is 28 years!"

Perhaps a larger task in the transition of the A&P stores to ACME standards has been the merchandising in the stores. "The first push was to get the stores full, fresh, friendly and clean," explains Gray. "We are expanding fresh in a big way at the new stores. Every store is going to have a power alley of fresh. We are also adding fresh cut produce, something they didn't have before," says Gray.


Making sure the transition to full, fresh, friendly and clean is successful in every store, ACME actively measures each location's CSI - Customer Service Index. "We measure CSI at every store by a survey on every cash receipt at checkout. If the store, or the department within the store, doesn't get a 9 or a 10, it's considered a zero. This is measured every day in every store," says Gray. "Then, we follow-up on every customer input that is below the 9 or 10 level to make sure the problem is addressed immediately."

Also important to the successful transition of the new ACME stores to the same success enjoyed by the legacy ACMEs is a strong investment in community outreach. Gray's team has a plan in place utilizing TV and radio, ROPs, target focused mailers and a strong push of charitable and community giving.

Gray believes that the company's current and future success is closely entwined with support from the vendor community. "Decentralization has been very important and key to our success. We make the decisions here and that means we need the vendors to bring their deals here. We want to grow our business, and that means we can grow their business at the same time. If a vendor makes a commitment to us. we will follow through and we will do what we say we will. Bring us any ideas, any thoughts you have. I encourage you to bring your focus to ACME and to take advantage of the talented group we have here. If you do, we will all benefit from the positive results."

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# Dan Dosenbach: At ACME, The People Make The Difference

Ten years ago, Dan Dosenbach made what some might view as radical career shift. He had joined ACME Markets after a successful career serving as the general counsel for the United Food and Commercial Workers in Chicago, a labor organization with 34,000 members. Now he would be literally "switching sides," working for management at one of the most iconic retail chains in the North-

However, Dosenbach never viewed the new job opportunity as anything close to being adversarial. "The goal is always the same for both parties," he explained. 'We both want to get our contracts settled fairly and I've always treated the people we bargain with respect, regardless of which side I've been on."

Now, as ACME's VP-human resources & labor relations, Dosenbach is the retailer's key link between some of its most important associates - the clerks and meatcutters who are employed at the company's 178 stores.

An attorney by background, Dosenbach said that wearing two hats not only keeps his job interesting, but allows him to utilize aspects of each role to improve the retailer's overall objectives.

"On the labor side, successfully bargaining contracts and the underlying administrative duties related to the job are very important. On the HR side, we are able to work with the associates on a more individualized basis. I'm a big believer in putting all of our associates in a position where they can maximize their strengths. We want to give them the opportunity to succeed while also challenging them to strive to reach the next level. We're all in the people business and that's why my job is so rewarding," he noted.

Dosenbach joined ACME when it was owned by Supervalu. While he acknowledges that things have changed considerably over the past decade (especially in the last three years since Albertsons LLC acquired the Malvern, PA-based chain), he views the upper management structures at each company primarily as differences in corporate philosophies.

"Supervalu's model was more process and expense driven. With the decentralized model at all the Albertsons companies now deeply with their divisions, we have more freedom and flexibility. It's a philosophy that I believe in because each market is different, and being allowed to focus on what's important to ACME and their associate allows all of us to accomplish our objectives more clearly."

For many years, trade observers viewed ACME's mature, unionized store level associate base as a competitive disadvan-

# Jeff Geiges: At ACME, It's Sales First, Sales Always

The man in charge of meat, seafood and pre-pack for ACME Markets is Jeff Geiges, a 37-year veteran of the company. He joined the company after studying at Wesley College. Over the course of his ACME career, Geiges has spent nine years in store operations, one year in human resources and 27 years in merchandising and procurement.

As sales manager for meat, seafood and pre-pack, Geiges is currently responsible for all merchandising and procurement, including writing the ads and developing the merchandising schemes, displays and store sets. He also oversees "people development," both inside and outside the stores. His team includes two assistant category managers and one department specialist. Together, these folks ensure that all of ACME's stores are on top of their game in meat and seafood.

With nearly four decades in the business, Geiges can certainly talk about the changes the industry has seen over the years. In the protein segment of the business especially, there have been many changes, Geiges explains. "Consumers' eating habits have changed. Gone are the days when families sat down to dinner at home seven days a week. More and more, families are going out to dinner. Even if they eat at home, it's not the traditional type of meal where everyone eats at the same time." Geiges and his team continue to introduce products and develop programs that can assist shoppers with solving their at-home dining needs.

What consumers are eating has changed, too, says Geiges. "There has been an explosion of natural and organics. Consumers, especially millennials, are much more nutrition-conscious these days. And, we've seen huge growth in the ethnic side of the business." These changes have been strongly influenced by the multiple channels of information available to consumers today, from the many TV cooking channels to instant access to information on the web through a wide variety of portals such as specialized apps and other online tools.

For this reason, ACME needs to be able to cater to many different needs and tastes, says Geiges. "We need to take care of ev-

eryone, from stay-at-home moms to millennials."

Geiges says meeting these goals has been strongly assisted under the new Albertsons umbrella where decentralization has been embraced. "In my 28 years of management, I've seen centralization tried three times. And I've seen it fail three times," Geiges says. "Today, we pride ourselves on being local, it's our lifeblood. Today, it's sales first, sales always."

As the company continues to grow, most recently with its acquisition of 71 former A&P stores, Geiges believes that vendor assistance will be vital to ACME's continued growth and success. He told us: "Over the past three years of decentralization, our preferred vendors have really come to the table and they have enjoyed double-digit growth every year." With this in mind, he tells the entire vendor community, "If you aren't bringing us your best deals, you're missing out. Come fast and come heavy, because we can sell some cases. When we do that, everybody wins - ACME, the vendors and the customers."

Mary Washinko, ACME's Markets' sales manager for deli and prepared foods, is a 40-year veteran of the Malvern, PA based retailer. She was promoted in 1985, taking a post in the company's Whippany, NJ office, as the deli-seafood buyer/merchandiser and continued in various positions in merchandising and marketing until 1999, when she was named senior category manager of service deli.



"The associates in the new stores see me every other week, and they're not used to that. They see that we are passionate about what we do, and they are happy to be part of the team."

Washinko's message to the vendor community: "Bring us innovation. Think outside the box when it comes to deli and prepared foods. Don't bring us the same old-same old. Know what's going on in our stores, what our customers want so you know what you should bring to us."

# Jenifer Krause: Bakery Innovation Keeps Sales Strong

Jenifer Krause, ACME Markets' fresh bakery sales manager, has been with the retailer for 28 years. Like so many others on the ACME team, Krause began her career in the stores, working through high school and college. 

In the new Albertsons era, ACME is thriving more than ever, O'Brien says. "Our business has improved a great deal under Bob Miller (Albertsons CEO). The autonounderstand the market and how to succeed locally. We have the nimbleness we need to operate at a very high level. The decision making ability is back in our hands, which vastly improves our speed to market, something that is vital to success for any retailer.'

The recent transition of the 71 former A&P stores that ACME acquired has been very smooth, O'Brien tells us. "Dan Croce's plans to convert these stores was a great one. Everyone worked very hard to get the stores re-opened. We still have a lot of work to do, but it is moving along at a pretty good clip. The store associates have been rejuvenated and feel reinvigorated, so overall it's been a very positive experience."

We asked O'Brien if he had a message for the vendor community about ACME Markets. He said: "We have three years under our belts to base our track record on. Business reviews have shown very good numbers for those three years. But, I feel we can drive the business much further if we have partnerships with our vendors that include innovative deals. Together we can all win."

They are getting on board with our goal to 'sell, sell, sell.' And, with the added stores, we have much more buying power now."

tage, especially when the company went through challenging times before 2013.

"Again, this is about people. I think we have a significant advantage in the market because of the experience and loyalty of our associates," Dosenbach stated. "Our associates' average tenure with the company is 28 years. Nobody knows the mar-

ket better than they do. And when we became decentralized three years ago and the associates were given renewed empowerment, their dedication and motivation were key drivers towards ACME's recent success. Everyone wants to be part of a winning team. Our associates not only embraced the changes we've made as a company – they've knocked it out of the park."

Dosenbach knows there are more challenges ahead. The market landscape has changed dramat-

ically in the past five years, with more and more retailers entering the food channel, many of them unorganized. Issues remain with health care and pension funds that need to be addressed.

But Dosenbach believes those hurdles can be cleared and refers back to his belief in the ACME game plan and strength and talent of its associates.










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
